BASEBALL TERMINOLOGY

Gapper – Ball hit between two outfielders.

Candy Hop - Easily fielded ground ball.

Pop Up - Weakly hit fly ball.

Texas Leaguer - Weakly hit fly ball that falls just over the infield for a base hit.

Round Tripper - A homerun.

BB, Pill, Seed - A ball hit extremely hard.

Ham 'n Egger - A ground ball hit to the left side where the runner is thrown out trying to advance to 3rd base.

Deuces - 2 balls, 2 strikes, and 2 outs.

Suicide - A play that combines the steal of home with a bunt by the batter; i.e. suicide squeeze.

Bang-Bang Play - A close play in which the runner arrives just before the ball.

Bomb - A deeply hit homerun.

Leading Lady - When the pitcher walks the first batter of an inning.

Hosed - When the runner is thrown out easily.

Cannon - A very strong arm.

Boot - A fielding error.

“K” - A strikeout.

Backwards “K” - A called strikeout.

Hat Trick - When a batter strikes out three times in one game.

Golden Sombrero - When a batter strikes out four times in one game.

The Cycle - Hitting a single, a double, a triple, and a homerun in one game.

On Fire - Hitting the ball well; On a roll.

Ribby - Run Batted In (RBI).

Rope - A hard hit ball that appears to be hit in a straight line; i.e. a frozen rope

Scoop - When a fielder catches a thrown ball out of the dirt.
